## Regulations winter storage

(1/10 until 1/4: prologation by agreement)

### Bottom of the ship

The bottom of all the ships will be pressure washed straight after hauling the ship out of the water. This will prevent fouling, which is very difficult to remove later on.

### Un-stepping and stepping of the mast and mast storage

The standard un-stepping and stepping of the mast means we will remove the boom and mast without sail, disconnect electric wiring, prepare the mast for transportation and stepping the mast the way it was removed before winter storage. Extra work can be filled out on the form.

Your registration for winter storage in the hall, implies that the mast will be stored in the mast storage. The boom will stay on board. To prevent damage to the mast it is not allowed to work on your mast in the mast storage. Should the mast remain on board, than we charge the overall length for the winter storage rate. The construction of the deck has to be suitable to carry the mast safely.

### Barge

All yachts are placed on universal barges, which fit onto our hydraulic boat car. Special cradles will be used for heavy or long yachts.

### Tarpaulins

We advise all ship owners, who leave their ship outside during the winter period, to put a tarpaulin over the ship. You can order a cover to fit your ship with us, we will have to be informed early. We do not rent out tarpaulins. We do not permit covers of thin plastic foil, because experience has taught us that they will rip (due to wind) very easily.

### Winter preparations for the engine & sanitary

This includes: an oil change of the engine, renew oil and fuel filters, preserve engine and sanitary with antifreeze (up to -20 °C).

When we prepare you ship for sailing, we will reconnect all the systems and check the V-belt and impeller. If necessary we will replace them. To prevent condensation we strongly advise you to fill your fuel tank completely before winter storage.

### Battery maintenance

We advise you to charge the batteries completely before the winter period. For all yachts all batteries should be disconnected. Disconnected batteries have no consumption and can be reconnected in spring. If batteries are due for replacement, for example due to aging, we can make you a competitive offer.

### Standardized and other work

On your winter storage registration form we have reserved some space on which you can write down the work you want us to carry out.

The place of your ship in the hall or outside will depend on the kind and amount of work that needs to be carried out. To ensure efficiency it is therefore very important that we know what work needs to be carried out, before the ship is hoisted out of the water. It is not allowed to leave gas bottles on board while your yacht is in our winter storage. You can store the bottles in our storage (see Various rates) or take them with you.

### Power connection
