Guidelines for winter storage (1/10 - 1/4: extension upon consultation)

Hull of the boat

The hull of all boats will be pressure washed straight after hauling the ship out of the water. This will prevent fouling, which is very difficult to remove later on

Un-stepping and stepping of the mast and mast storage

The standard un-stepping and stepping of the mast means we will remove the boom and mast without sail, prepare the mast for transportation and stepping the mast the way it was removed before winter storage. Extra work can be filled out on the form.

Your registration for winter storage in the hall, implies that the mast will be stored in the mast storage. The boom will stay on board. To prevent damage to the mast it is not allowed to work on your mast in the mast storage. Should the mast remain on board, than we charge the overall length for the winter storage rate. The construction of the deck has to be suitable to carry the mast safely.

Barge

All boats are placed on universal barges, which fit onto our hydraulic boat car. Special cradles will be used for heavy or long boats.

Covers

For safety reasons, winter tents, tarpaulins, and other types of coverings that may become detached or impose extra load on the boat or its cradle are not allowed while stored on land.

Winter preparations for engine and sanitary

By this we mean protect engine and sanitary with antifreeze, drain water where possible and reconnect systems in the spring.

Battery Maintenance

We recommend that you present the batteries in charged condition. All batteries must be disconnected, when the boat is stored in our hall. With disconnected batteries there is no consumption and they can be reconnected in the spring. Should batteries need replacement due to for example aging, we can make you a competitive offer.

Standardized an other work

The location of your boat in the hall or outside will depend on the kind and amount of work that needs to be carried out. To ensure efficiency it is therefore very important that we know what work needs to be carried out, before the boat is hoisted out of the water in order to avoid extra transport costs. For boats with outdoor storage, work on the ship is weather-dependent. In accordance with the Hiswa Conditions it is not allowed to leave gas bottles on board during winter storage. You can store the gas bottles at the applicable rate with us or take them with you.

Power connection
